

Rogers Area Youth Baseball Game Cancellation / Rescheduling Procedure

NOTE: If the School District or City of Rogers cancels games before 4PM, we will do our best to put a notice on the Rogers Web-site so please check there for updates when threatening weather is approaching. After 4PM, the decision is up to the coaches on the field.

Minors / Majors: Since these games do not require umpires, please try to reschedule your games for sometime during your scheduled practice times. If you need help finding a slot that is open, please contact Aaron Cook. If you can't find an open slot, please talk directly to coaches that have a practice slot already filled to see if you can get them to move / adjust their practice time for you to fit in a game. All rescheduled Minors / Majors games or practice changes must go through Aaron Cook so he can make sure the Master schedule is updated. Please also send an email to info@rogersyouthbaseball.org and mcpinter@charter.net so that we can track these changes.

4th / 5th-6th Grade House: If a game is cancelled (either by the School District, City of Rogers/Otsego or on the field), it is the responsibility of the HOME team's coach to do the following:

1. Contact the umpire coordinator Dan Feigum at 612-802-5661 to alert him of the cancellation. Dan will contact the umpire to let them know (assuming the cancellation was before game time).
2. Contact the opposing coach so that you both are in-sync about the cancellation and makeup game procedure.
3. Contact your league commissioner to let them know the game was cancelled. Commissioners: Please track all games that must be made up so we don't miss any.
4. Send an email to "info@rogersyouthbaseball.org" denoting the specifics of the cancelled game (League, Date, Time, Field, Teams involved)

If the game is cancelled **before June 14**, all makeup games will be scheduled for the weekend of June 14-15. The league commissioners will work out the schedule for makeup games that weekend and alert coaches as soon as that schedule is available.

If the game is cancelled **after June 14**, the Home team coach must also do the following:

1. Go to the Rogers Area Youth Baseball web-site and using the Master Schedule (found under Practice Schedule), find a date for a makeup game (try not to bump practices if at all possible). It is OK to schedule Friday night games if you have to.
 2. If you had to bump a practice, please notify the coach that was bumped so that they can work out a new practice time with Aaron Cook (612-269-5375). All practice changes need to go through Aaron Cook.
 3. Send an email to info@rogersyouthbaseball.org and mcpinter@charter.net to alert us of the rescheduled game so it will show up in the Master schedule. Include League, Date, Time, Field and Teams involved and any info regarding "bumped practices".
 4. Notify Dan Feigum at dfeigum@charter.net, to alert him of the rescheduled game so that Dan can schedule an umpire. Do not assume you have an umpire unless you get confirmation from Dan Feigum.

Travel / 7th - 12th Grade House: If a game is cancelled, the Home team coach must do the following:

1. Contact the umpire coordinator, Dan Feigum, at 612-802-5661 to alert him of the cancellation. Dan will contact the umpire to let them know (assuming the cancellation was before game time).
2. Contact your MYAS (Gopher State) league coordinator to alert them of the cancelled game (this info is in your coaches packet). MYAS will update the web-site so that the game will show up as cancelled.
3. Contact the opposing coach so that they know the game is cancelled and you can work out a date for a makeup game.
4. Go to the Rogers Area Youth Baseball web-site and using the Master Schedule (found under Practice Schedule), find a date for a makeup game (try not to bump practices if at all possible), fill out a Reschedule Form and send/fax/email that to the MYAS office (this information and procedure is also in your coaches packet). If you have any questions about rescheduling a game or are unsure if a slot is available, please contact Aaron Cook at 612-269-5375 to discuss.
5. If you had to bump a practice, please notify the coach that was bumped so that they can work out a new practice time with Aaron Cook (612-269-5375). All practice changes need to go through Aaron.
6. Send an email to info@rogersyouthbaseball.org and mcpinter@charter.net to alert us of the rescheduled game so it will show up in the Master schedule. Include League, Date, Time, Field and Teams involved.
7. Notify Dan Feigum at dfeigum@charter.net, to alert him of the rescheduled game so that Dan can schedule an umpire. Do not assume you have an umpire unless you get confirmation from Dan Feigum.
